

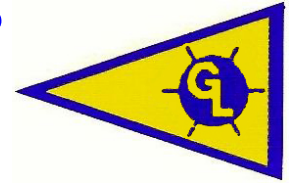
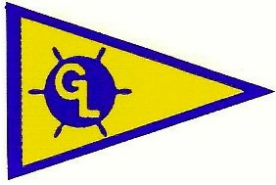
# NOTICE OF RACE

## 2017 GLYC EarlyBird/Leukemia Cup Regatta

May 19 & 20, 2017

### GREAT LAKES YACHT CLUB

St. Clair Shores, Michigan



#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 Great Lakes Yacht Club (GLYC) is the Organizing Authority (OA) for the 2017 GLYC EarlyBird/Leukemia Cup Regatta. Sponsoring Clubs include the Detroit Yacht Club (DYC), Lake Shore Sail Club (LSSC), and Crescent Sail Yacht Club (CSYC).
- 1.2 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020 (RRS).
- 1.3 The following will apply: DYC "Detroit River Course" Sailing Instructions; "LSSC Cruising Course" Sailing Instructions; 2017 DRYA Sponsoring Clubs Sailing Instructions for "A" and "C" Courses; the "MISSA Leukemia Cup Regatta" Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions.
- 1.4 All Sailing Instructions may change other racing rules.
- 1.5 Where a conflict exists between the NOR and any Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will govern. This changes rule 63.7.
- 1.6 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and the course specific sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located in the GLYC Clubhouse. #### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The Early Bird Regatta is open to DRYA Registered Yachts. The Leukemia Cup Regatta is open to Yachts/Kayaks & Paddle Boards registered with the Leukemia Society. Leukemia Cup registration is available at [www.greatlakesyc.com](http://www.greatlakesyc.com) under the Leukemia Cup tab select desired race course and follow the link to register. (crew registration is optional).

#### 3 FEES

- 3.1 To qualify for the "Leukemia Cup Awards" competitors must be registered and pay the following fee (all fees are donated to the Leukemia Lymphoma Society):

<b>DYC "Detroit River Course":</b>	\$25*	Yachts/Kayaks & Paddle Boards
<b>DRYA "A" &amp; "C" Course:</b>	\$100*	Yachts
<b>LSSC "Cruising Course":</b>	\$100*	Yachts
<b>MISSA Tier Three Course:</b>	\$30	Each Sailor

(\*optional crew registration \$25 per person)

#### 4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration must be completed with fee paid by Noon on Thursday, May 18, 2017.
- 4.2 Schedule of Races and time of Warning Signal:

<b>DRYA "A" Course</b>	1030 hrs,	Saturday, May 20, 2017
<b>DRYA "C" Course</b>	1030 hrs,	Saturday, May 20, 2017
<b>LSSC "Cruising Course"</b>	1030 hrs,	Saturday, May 20, 2017
<b>MISSA "Tier Three Course"</b>	0800 hrs,	Saturday, May 20, 2017

#### 5 MEASUREMENT

- 5.1 All sailing yachts shall have a valid PHRF rating certificate, be listed on the 2017 DRYA 'P\_JAM' rating list or accept an assigned PHRF rating by the OA.

#### 6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL COURSES

The sailing instructions for each course will be available by May 1, 2017 at [greatlakesyc.com/race/](http://greatlakesyc.com/race/), or at the Great Lakes Yacht Club office, located at 23900 Jefferson Avenue, St. Clair Shores, MI; Phone 586.778.9510.

#### 7 VENUE/COURSES

Racing will take place at the following approximate starting areas: DRYA "A" Course N. 42° 25.15, W. 082° 51.250'; DRYA "C" Course N. 42° 22.15', W. 082° 52.00'; DYC "Detroit River Course" in front of the DYC Main Dock; LSSC "Cruising Course" N. 42°28.50', W. 82°51.00'; MISSA "Tier Three Course" at Crescent Sail Yacht Club (CSYC), 276 Lake Shore, Grosse Pointe Farms, Michigan. ## 8 BERTHING

Unoccupied slips in the GLYC Harbor will be available to participating yachts from Noon on Friday, May 19th through Noon on Sunday, May 21st. Contact the club office at 586.778.9510 or e-mail at [greatlakesyachtclub@gmail.com](mailto:greatlakesyachtclub@gmail.com)

## 9 PENALTY SYSTEM

Penalties for sailing yachts shall be as provided in RRS 44.1 or as modified by sailing instructions.

## 10 SCORING

Time-on-Time scoring will be in effect for all PHRF classes.

## 11 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

If specified in the individual Sailing Instructions for each course, the Race Committee may provide general information to competitors on a designated courtesy channel. The failure to broadcast such information or the broadcast of incorrect information shall not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. The restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## 12 SUPPORT VESSELS

Race Committee Support Vessels shall display a flag marked "RC".

## 13 PRIZES

Awards will be presented as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions for each course.

## 14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in this regatta at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision of Race. The OA, the Race Committees, the protest committee and the regatta sponsors will not accept any liability for property damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

## 15 INSURANCE

The owner of each participating boat is responsible to maintain liability insurance.
