## Notice of Race



### **32<sup>nd</sup> 1 + 1 Regatta & 30th Single-Handed Regatta**

**First Warning Signal at 1055hrs (10:55am) Sunday, June 10, 2018**

**Rules:** Great Lakes Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority for this Regatta. The race will be governed by these Sailing Instructions and The Racing Rules of Sailing RRS, including US Sailing Prescriptions, except as stated herein. The races will be managed by the GLYC Race Committee, which will have the authority to establish the racing conditions and interpret the racing rules.

**Eligibility:** The regatta is open to all seaworthy mono-hull sailing yachts with a valid PHRF rating. If you do not have a current PHRF rating you may obtain one through the DRYA Web Site at [www.drya.org](http://www.drya.org).

**Entry/Fee:** All entrants must register for the regatta by completing the registration form found at [greatlakesyc.com](http://greatlakesyc.com) and paying an entry fee of \$40 for single-handed boats and \$50 for 1+1 boats. The completed Registration Form including payment of fees must be received by the GLYC Race Committee, Great Lakes Yacht Club, 23900 Jefferson Ave., St. Clair Shores, MI 48080, no later than Wednesday, June 6, 2018. No retroactive scoring of races will occur for non-registered boats. Unregistered yachts will not be scored. Entry forms are available at [greatlakesyc.com](http://greatlakesyc.com).

**Schedule:** Registration must be completed with fee paid by 1500 hours on Wednesday, June 6, 2018. The warning signal for the first start will be at 1055 hours on Sunday, June 10, 2018. Class splits and start times will be posted on the GLYC website by the Friday, June 8, 2018. Early registration by participants aids the OA in determining fair and reasonable class splits.

**Measurement:** All sailing yachts shall have a valid PHRF rating certificate, be listed on the 2018 DRYA 'PJAM' rating list or accept an assigned PHRF rating by the OA.

**Sailing Instructions:** The sailing instructions will be available by 1500 hours on Friday, June 8, 2018 at [greatlakesyc.com](http://greatlakesyc.com), or at the Great Lakes Yacht Club office, located at 23900 Jefferson Avenue, St. Clair Shores, MI; Phone 586.778.9510. Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted in the GLYC Clubhouse and posted to [greatlakesyc.com](http://greatlakesyc.com).

**Course:** This Point to Point race is approximately 14.5NM on Lake St. Clair. The start and finish is located approximately 1/2 mile East of the St. Clair Shores Coast Guard Station, and is approximately 0.4 NM East of "GR" at approximately 42° 28.50'N, 82° 51.00'W. The Course details and class assignments are set forth in the Sailing Instructions. (see Sailing Instructions for Details).

**Berthing:** Unoccupied slips in the GLYC Harbor will be available to participating yachts from Noon on Friday, June 8th through Noon on Monday, June 11th Contact the club office at 586.778.9510 or e-mail to [greatlakesyachtclub@gmail.com](mailto:greatlakesyachtclub@gmail.com) to make arrangements.

**Penalty System:** Penalties for sailing yachts shall be as provided in RRS 44.1 or as modified by sailing instructions.

**Race Results, Changes, and Handicapping:** Race results will be posted at [www.greatlakesyc.com](http://www.greatlakesyc.com) under "1+1 Regatta" as soon as possible following the race. Time-on-Time will be used to calculate the results. Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the GLYC bulletin board adjacent to the Office in the GLYC Clubhouse and at [www.gratlakesyc.com](http://www.gratlakesyc.com), under "1+1 Regatta". Each competing yacht shall have a current PHRF rating. If you do not have a current PHRF rating, one can be obtain through the Detroit Regional Yacht-Racing Association (DRYA). Membership in and handicapping by DRYA is strongly encouraged. More DRYA information is available at [www.drya.org](http://www.drya.org).

**Scoring:** Boats in all classes will be scored according to their corrected times, calculated on a time-on-time basis. The Low Point Scoring System (RRS Appendix A) will apply.

**Awards:** Awards will be presented for each class as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions.

**Radio Communications** the Race Committee may provide general information to competitors on a designated courtesy channel. The failure to broadcast such information or the broadcast of incorrect information shall not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. The restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

**Support Boats:** Support boats shall display a flag marked "RC".

**Disclaimer of Liability:** Competitors participate in this regatta at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision of Race. The OA, the Race Committees, the protest committee and the regatta sponsors will not accept any liability for property damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta
