2018 GLYC EarlyBird/Leukemia Cup Regatta

May 12,18 & 19, 2018

1 RULES

- 1.1 Great Lakes Yacht Club (GLYC) is the Organizing Authority (OA) for the 2018 GLYC EarlyBird/Leukemia Cup Regatta, a package of Regattas on five different courses. Sponsoring Clubs include the Detroit Yacht Club (DYC), Lake Shore Sail Club (LSSC), Crescent Sail Yacht Club (CSYC) and Grosse Pointe Yacht Club (GPYC).
- 1.2 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020 (RRS), including the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US Sailing)
- 1.3 Venues. GLYC EarlyBird Regatta; DRYA "A" and "C" Course; DYC "Detroit River Course"; "LSSC Cruising Course" and "MISSA Leukemia Cup Regatta"
- 1.4 The GLYC Sailing Instructions and Course Instruction Guide. Sailing Instructions may change other racing rules.
- 1.5 Where a conflict exists between the NOR and any Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will govern. This changes rule 63.7.
- 1.6 The sailing instructions will be posted online and on the official notice boards located in the GLYC and Sponsoring Clubs Clubhouses.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The Early Bird Regatta is open to DRYA Registered Yachts. The Leukemia Cup Regatta is open to Yachts/Kayaks, Paddle Boards registered with the Leukemia Society and MISSA Sailors registered in the High School Leukemia Cup Regatta. All Leukemia Cup registration is available at www.greatlakesyc.com under the Leukemia Cup tab, select desired race course and follow the link to register. (crew registration is optional).

3 FEES

- 3.1 To qualify for the "Leukemia Cup Awards" competitors must be registered and pay the following fee (all fees are donated to the Leukemia Lymphoma Society):

DYC "Detroit River Course":	\$25*	Flying Scots, Kayaks & Paddle Boards,
DRYA "A" & "C" Course:	\$100*	Yachts
LSSC "Cruising Course":	\$100*	Yachts
MISSA Tier Three Course:	\$30	Each Sailor

(*optional crew registration \$25 per person)

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration must be completed with fee paid by Noon on Thursday, May 10, 2018.
- 4.2 Schedule of Races and time of Warning Signal:

LSSC "Cruising Course"	1030 hrs,	Saturday, May 19, 2018

5 MEASUREMENT

- 5.1 All sailing yachts shall have a valid PHRF rating certificate, be listed on the 2018 DRYA 'P_JAM' rating list or accept an assigned PHRF rating by the OA. A list of all invited guest boats will be supplied to DRYA at least 4 days prior the the Regatta date. The list shall contain sail number, owners name, name of boat and type and class entered in. (Available on the DRYA website)

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL COURSES

The sailing instructions for each course will be available on or before May 11, 2018 at greatlakesyc.com, or at the Great Lakes Yacht Club office, located at 23900 Jefferson Avenue, St. Clair Shores, MI; Phone 586.778.9510.

7 VENUE/COURSES

Racing will take place at the following approximate starting areas: DRYA "A" Course N. 42° 25.15', W. 082° 51.250'; DRYA "C" Course N. 42° 22.00', W. 082° 52.20'; DYC "Detroit River Course" in front of the DYC Main Dock; LSSC "Cruising Course" N. 42°28.50', W. 82°51.00'; MISSA "Tier Three Course" at Grosse Pointe Yacht Club (GPYC), 788 Lake Shore Rd. Grosse Pointe Shores, Michigan, in front of the Sailing Center. See specific course Sailing Instructions for details. Published Instructions are available at greatlakesyc/race/.com

8 BERTHING

Unoccupied slips in the GLYC Harbor will be available to participating yachts from Noon on Friday, May 18th through Noon on Sunday, May 20th. Contact the club office at 586.778.9510 or e-mail at greatlakesyachtclub@gmail.com

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

Penalties for sailing yachts shall be as provided in RRS 44.1 or as modified by sailing instructions.

10 SCORING

Time-on-Time scoring will be in effect for all PHRF classes.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

If specified in the individual Sailing Instructions for each course, the Race Committee may provide general information to competitors on a designated courtesy channel. The failure to broadcast such information or the broadcast of incorrect information shall not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. The restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12 SUPPORT VESSELS

Race Committee Support Vessels shall display a flag marked "RC".

13 PRIZES

Awards will be presented as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions for each course.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in this regatta at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision of Race. The OA, the Race Committees, the protest committee and the regatta sponsors will not accept any liability for property damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

15 INSURANCE

The owner of each participating boat is responsible to maintain liability insurance.
