Great Lakes Yacht Club invites your participation in our combined Single-Handed and Double-Handed Regatta, on Sunday, June 9th, 2019 on Lake St. Clair. This 14.5nm (approximate) Point to Point race starts and finishes approximately 100 yards east of the Gaukler Point Shoal Buoy which is located east of the St. Clair Shores Coast Guard station.

**ENTRIES:** Complete Registration / Application forms and return, with entry fee, to GLYC no later than the Wednesday June 5th. Class splits will be available at GLYC after 1800 hours, on Friday June 7th. Late registration applications will be accepted for an additional \$10 fee. Sailing Instructions will be posted at [greatlakesyc.com](http://greatlakesyc.com) by the Wednesday before the race with printed copies in the GLYC Clubhouse.

**FEE:** The entry fee is \$40 for single-handed boats and \$50 for 1+1 boats. The entry fee includes one dinner for each competitor. Additional dinners may be purchased at \$20 per person. All fees are payable in US\$. Deduct \$5 from the entry fee if you include proof of USSA Membership. Payment by credit card can be made for a small additional fee. Contact GLYC club manager at 586.778.9510 to make arrangements.
