Notice of Race

34th 1 + 1 Regatta & 32nd Single-Handed Regatta

Sunday, June 7, 2020

First Warning Signal at 1055hrs (10:55am)

Rules: Great Lakes Yacht Club (GLYC) is the Organizing Authority (OA). Racing will be governed by these Sailing Instructions (SI's) and the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), including US Sailing Prescriptions, except as stated herein. Races will be managed by the GLYC Race Committee, with the authority to establish the racing conditions and interpret the racing rules.

Eligibility and Entry: The regatta is open to all seaworthy mono-hull sailing yachts who hold membership in GLYC and other yachts by invitation of the Race Committee. Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form found at greatlakesyc.com and paying a \$20 entry fee for single-handed boats and a \$25 fee for 1+1 boats. Send completed registration form, with fee, to GLYC Race Committee, Great Lakes Yacht Club, 23900 Jefferson Ave., St. Clair Shores, MI 48080, by Wednesday, June 3, 2019. There is a late registration fee of \$10 for applications received after June 3, 2020. You may pay the fee with a credit card (add \$1 fee), contact the GLYC office at 586.778.9510.

Schedule: Warning signal for the first start will be at 1055 hours on Sunday, June 7, 2020. Class splits and start times will be posted on the GLYC website by the Friday, June 5, 2019.

Measurement: All sailing yachts shall have a valid PHRF rating certificate, be listed on the 2020 DRYA 'PJAM' rating list or accept an assigned PHRF rating by the OA.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing instructions will be posted by 1500 hours on Friday, June 5, 2020, at greatlakesyc.com, or in the GLYC office, located at 23900 Jefferson Avenue, St. Clair Shores, MI; Phone 586.778.9510. Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted in the GLYC Clubhouse and posted on greatlakesyc.com.

Course: This Point to Point race is approximately 14.5NM on Lake St. Clair. The start and finish is located approximately 0.4 NM East of "GR" at approximately 42° 28.50'N, 82° 51.00'W. The Course details and class assignments are set forth in the Sailing Instructions. (see Sailing Instructions for Details).

Penalty System: Penalties for sailing yachts, RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by the One Turn Penalty.

Scoring: Boats in all classes will be scored according to their corrected times, calculated on a time-on-time basis.

Support Boats: Support boats shall display a flag marked "RC".

Radio Communications: The Race Committee may provide general information to competitors on channel 72. The failure to broadcast such information or the broadcast of incorrect information shall not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. The restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

Awards: Awards will be PUBLISHED for each class on the GLYC and DRYA websites as soon as possible after the race. greatlakesyc.com. Award flags will be mailed.

Disclaimer of Liability: Competitors participate in this regatta at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision of Race. The OA, the Race Committees, the protest committee and the regatta sponsors will not accept any liability for property damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta

It is recommended that all participants follow Government regulations and guidelines during the Covid-19 Pandemic.
