1 ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

- 1.1 Great Lakes Yacht Club (GLYC) is the Organizing Authority (OA) for the 2020 GLYC Night Race
- 1.2 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020 (RRS), including the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US Sailing)
- 1.3 Where a conflict exists between the NOR and any Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will govern. This changes rule 63.7.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The 2020 GLYC Night Race is open to DRYA Registered Yachts and invited participants of the (OA).

3 FEES

- 3.1 There is no entry fee for this regatta.

4 RULES

- 4.1 These races are governed by the 2020 Detroit Regional Yacht-Racing Association (DRYA) Sailing Instructions, except as modified in the Sailing Instructions for the 2020 GLYC Night Race, and except as modified herein.
- 4.2 Sailing Instructions may change other racing rules.
- 4.3 Where a conflict exists between the NOR and any Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will govern. This changes rule 63.7.
- 4.4 The sailing instructions will be posted online at greatlakesyc.com under GLYC Night Race.

5 MEASUREMENT

- 5.1 All sailing yachts shall have a valid PHRF rating certificate, be listed on the 2020 DRYA 'P_JAM' rating list or accept an assigned PHRF rating by the OA. A list of all invited guest boats will be supplied to DRYA at least 4 days prior the Regatta date. The list shall contain sail number, owners name, name of boat and type and class entered in. (Available on the DRYA website)

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on or before June 20, 2020 at greatlakesyc.com, under "GLYC Night Race" or at drya.org, under 'Calendars & Schedules'.

7 VENUE/COURSES

Racing will take place on a triangular long course of approximately 20 nautical miles and a short course of approximately 13 nautical miles, starting and finishing off of Grosse Pointe Yacht Club. See specific course Sailing Instructions for details. Published Instructions are available at greatlakesyc.com/race/. The Warning signal for the first start will be at 1855hrs (6:55pm).

8 PRIZES

Awards will be presented as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions.

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in this regatta at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision of Race. The OA, the Race Committees, the protest committee, and the regatta sponsors will not accept any liability for property damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
